

# AIMS AND SCOPE

Journal of Historical, Archaeological and Anthropological Studies (JHAAS) is a bi-annual peer-reviewed journal which focused on publishing the highest quality papers covering all aspects of history, archaeology and anthropology. This is an effort to bring out current research and ideas together on a platform that will enhance knowledge of our past cultures and seeks to explore the close links between the different disciplines. Reconstruction of history is partly dependent upon the archaeological sources which provide a vital component in the reconstruction of not only the remote past but also of the not-so-distant one. Archaeological and anthropological studies is a direct impact on society, which cannot be studied without its historical context. Even modern aspects of anthropology and archaeology jointly need to be examined in light of the social forces that have shaped them. Submissions should address issues and questions of broad interest in the archaeology of the Indian subcontinent and interpretation of new and previously reported archaeological materials. Archaeology as well as anthropology provides insights into past cultures, especially where there is a dearth of written records. The present journal is a suitable platform for the scholars of different disciplines who can examine and explore the inter-related nature of the disciplines of history, archaeology and anthropology using a holistic approach. Moreover, publication of short communications on discoveries, seminar reports, and conferences are also invited. The journal also publishes review papers from senior researchers in their respective fields of research.

**Plagiarism policy:** Every paper should accompany a similarity index report in Turnitinanti plagiarism software. The plagiarism percentage should not exceed 10-15% per cent (excluding 8 words). Further, it should not be more than one per cent from one source.

# **INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS**

Scholars are invited to submit their original, unpublished research papers for the Journal of Historical, Archaeological and Anthropological Studies (JHAAS), a bi-annual peer-reviewed journal that seeks to explore the close links between the different disciplines of history, archaeology and anthropology. Deliberations on different aspects of the history of the world based on the great variety of newly emerging historical approaches, archaeological practices and emerging new trends in anthropology can facilitate a re-evaluation of existing material by historians, archaeologists and anthropologists to help fill up the gaps in our knowledge through an inter-disciplinary approach. Papers may be submitted in any of the following disciplines:-

- Different aspects of history at the global level, including social & life sciences.
- Any aspect of anthropology, examined through a historicalanthropological lens.
- Various aspects of archaeological studies including recent explorations, excavations and applied as well as environmental archaeology.

# GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ARTICLES

- The Research papers should have an inter-disciplinary and holistic approach.
- · Submissions should be in the English language only.
- The research papers should be original, not be previously published and not submitted to any other journal for publication.
- Please send the paper in Microsoft Office Word 2007 [Compatibility Mode] File via the following E-mail address: farswanys@gmail.com or eicjhaas@gmail.com
- The cover page should have the following information:-
  - (i) The Title of Paper
- (ii) Names of the author/s
- (iii) Designation and Institutional affiliation of the Author/s (if any)
- (iv) E-mail ID/s
- (v) Phone no/s
- The author/s name should not appear in the rest of the article
- 1. Articles should not be more than 5000 words in English and subheadings, if any, should be short and meaningful.

The submission must include an abstract of 150-250 words which should contain a minimum of five keywords arranged alphabetically.

- Era designations are to be expressed in CE (the Common Era) and BCE (Before Common Era) instead of AD and BC. (e.g. 200 BCE to 350 CE.)
- Particular centuries are spelt out and in lower case, such as From the sixth to ninth century CE.
  - b) The sixth century BCE
  - c) The seventh and eighth centuries
- Quotations should be a part of the text with 'single inverted comma'; quotation within a quotation should be within "double inverted comma"

## 2. The style of reference, is to be through in-text citation

- by 'author year: pp' for books (e.g. Bhattacharya 1992: 221-8 and not 221-228) and 'author year' for articles (e.g. Dhavalikar 1989).
- In the case of more than one citation for a single fact/ interpretation, the pattern should be first alphabetical and then chronological (e.g. Chakravarty 1977, Dasgupta 1999, Morrison 1998, 1999 and so on).

#### 3. Bibliography

- An extended list of references titled BIBLIOGRAPHY should be included in alphabetical order at the end of the text/paper.
- In case of BOOK Author/s, Year, The title of the book in italics, Place: Publisher (reprinted year, place: publisher); e.g.

- In case of edited BOOK Surname of the author (ed.), Year, The title of the book in italics, Place: Publisher (reprinted year, place: publisher)
- In case of CHAPTER Author/s, Year, The title of the chapter/Article, The title of the book in italics, pp. Place: Publisher
- In case of JOURNAL Author/s, Year, The title of the Article, Name of the journal that published the article in Italics, Volume No: pp.
- In case of ONLINE Author/s, Year, The title (if any). The link, i.e. URL (last date of accession).
- 4. Photographs and Illustrations/Tables, Graphs, etc. may be in colour or B/W in JPEG format with a short caption.

Photos (in JPEG format) and diagrams with a short caption should be attached to the text where necessary with proper acknowledgement of the source. A list of illustrations may be given in detail. The Editors will not be responsible for copyright clearance for photos or illustrations used. The author/s has/have the sole responsibility of obtaining permission for using someone else's illustrations and/or satellite imagery.

5. Acknowledgements, if any, should be placed between the text and the Bibliography.

#### 6. The Text

- Should be typed with spacing 1.5 in the normal margin.
- Main Text should be typed in MS Office Word 2007 with a font size of 12 and the type of font is considered in Times New Roman
- All non-English words should be in italics, e.g. the Padma, and diacritical marks should be used, e.g. ? Sana, jñ?na mudr?.
- Names of books should also be in italics e.g. Agni Purna N.B. The sole responsibility for the point of view and for the opinion will be that of the author/s. The Editor/s of the journal will not be liable for opinions expressed.
